

## Schedule and Details UPDATE 1.14.10

### **Kentucky Intercollegiate Orchestra 2010**

Wednesday, Feb 3rd Rehearsals: Male High School, Louisville

Thursday, Feb 4th Rehearsals and Concert: Whitney Hall

(Kentucky Center for the Arts--KCA)

Thank you for your preparation thus far on your KIO music, getting it ready for our February 3--4 experience. While the basic schedule and details shared below have not changed since you received your folders back in late November, I wanted to add some directions and further details on our rehearsal location, Male High School, plus a few reminders. But before that, one very important matter:

**PLEASE BE SURE TO BRING A FOLDING STAND WITH YOU - YOU MUST HAVE THIS FOR THE REHEARSAL IN TODD HALL THURSDAY MORNING**

**DIRECTIONS:** Located off I-65 on the south side of Louisville, just beyond the interchange of I-65 and the Watterson Expressway (Out near airport).

To get to Male HS, come off the Preston Hwy. exit off of I-65. If coming from I-65 South (traveling south away from city), turn left at the bottom of the ramp then left again onto Preston. If you come I-65 north (towards Louisville), take the Preston Hwy [RT 130]. exit and turn left at the end of the ramp. This is Preston Highway. You will pass a cemetery. At the end of the cemetery, turn **right** into the parking lot. There's a sign for **JCPS Gheens Academy**. Go into the first lot -- this is where everyone can park throughout Wednesday.

Come in the door by the Building marked far up and to the right in the parking lot as you can. There is a large air conditioning unit in the upper right corner. Signs will be posted directing you to the auditorium, which will be our place for coats and cases (not on stage, of course).

**FOOD:** There are quite a few restaurants and fast food places in the immediate vicinity of the high school. If you turn **RIGHT** out of the parking lot, you will find shortly: McDonalds, Taco Bell, Subway, KFC, Pizza Hut, Rallys, Shoney's, White Castle, etc. When you turn **LEFT** out of the parking lot: immediately a Bob Evans, Waffle House, and a bit later Popeyes, McDinalds, Burger King, Fazzolis, etc

You should plan to arrive by no later than **9:45 am Eastern Standard Time**. When you come in, Winds and Percussion will go immediately into rehearsal on the stage, while strings audition for their seats within their already assigned section. There will be signs and folks helping to get to the string audition rooms:

Violin 1: G05--06 (Ground level)

Violin 2: 205--206 (Same basic spot, second floor)

Viola and Bases: Orchestra room for basses, and violas inn practice room at  
Top of stairs off Orchestra room (Be sensitive to that arrangement)  
Cello: Front lobby of auditorium

Rehearsal timings within the large rehearsal blocks, and any necessary sectionals, will be at the discretion of our guest conductor, Joel Neves.
