The 2010 KMEA Intercollegiate Orchestra will be performing three works at the annual KMEA Intercollegiate Concert, Thursday evening, February 4, 2010:

March Slav (Tchaikovsky)
Finale (Mvt 5: Allegretto--Allegro) from Symphony #9 (Shostakovich)
Carnival Overture (Dvorak)

A brass, woodwind, percussion, or harp players in a Kentucky college or university may submit an audition CD and an application form. The applicant's form must be signed by his/her band director, orchestra director, or studio teacher, who must be a member of KME.. [Directors nominate Strings--see your director for details].

The required audition excerpts (drawn from the Tchaikovsky and the Dvorak) are posted on the KMEA.org website.

Students will need to supply their own CD with the following information **ON THE PAPER SLEEVE OR JEWEL CASE ONLY:**

1. Student name
2. Instrument
3. University or College
4. Faculty Sponsor (must be member of KMEA)
5. KMEA Sponsor #

It is important for anonymity that the CDs themselves not be marked.

Additionally, please have each applicant fill out the form shown at the bottom of this posting. Please be sure each applicant has submitted both a CD, marked as noted above, and an application, endorsed by an instrumental faculty member who is a KMEA member.

The CDs are due to Dr. Bill Scott on Monday, Oct. 5th. He plans to mail them out to our adjudicators on Tuesday, Oct. 6th.
