President's Report (Bill K.)

Select Band Report (Bill K.)

Select band conductors for 2012 have verbally committed. Contracts pending. They are David Starnes (WE), Brant Karrick (Sym), Kevin Bowling (MS).

Bill would like to begin scheduling for 2013. Select band committee will collect nominations from the membership to be voted on and ranked.

Select band rehearsal space--- SB committee will recommend an option for rehearsal space adjustments in order to get the wind ensemble out of the choir room.
